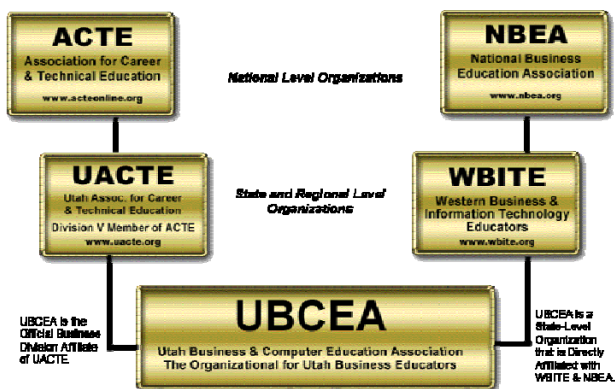
## What is UBCEA?
